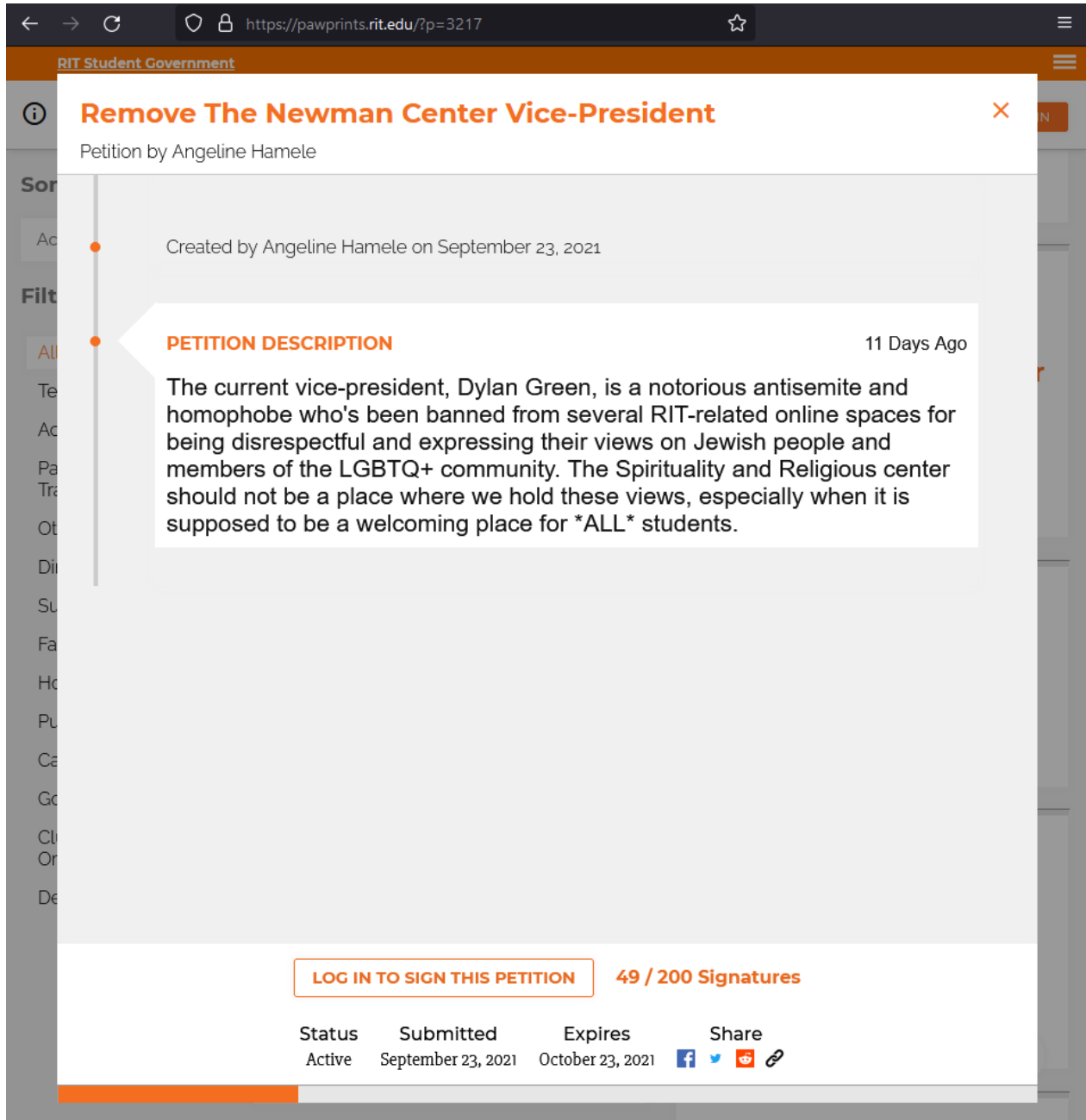


Figure 1: The first pawprints

The similarity in wording and retaliatory nature of this petition inspired us to dig deeper.

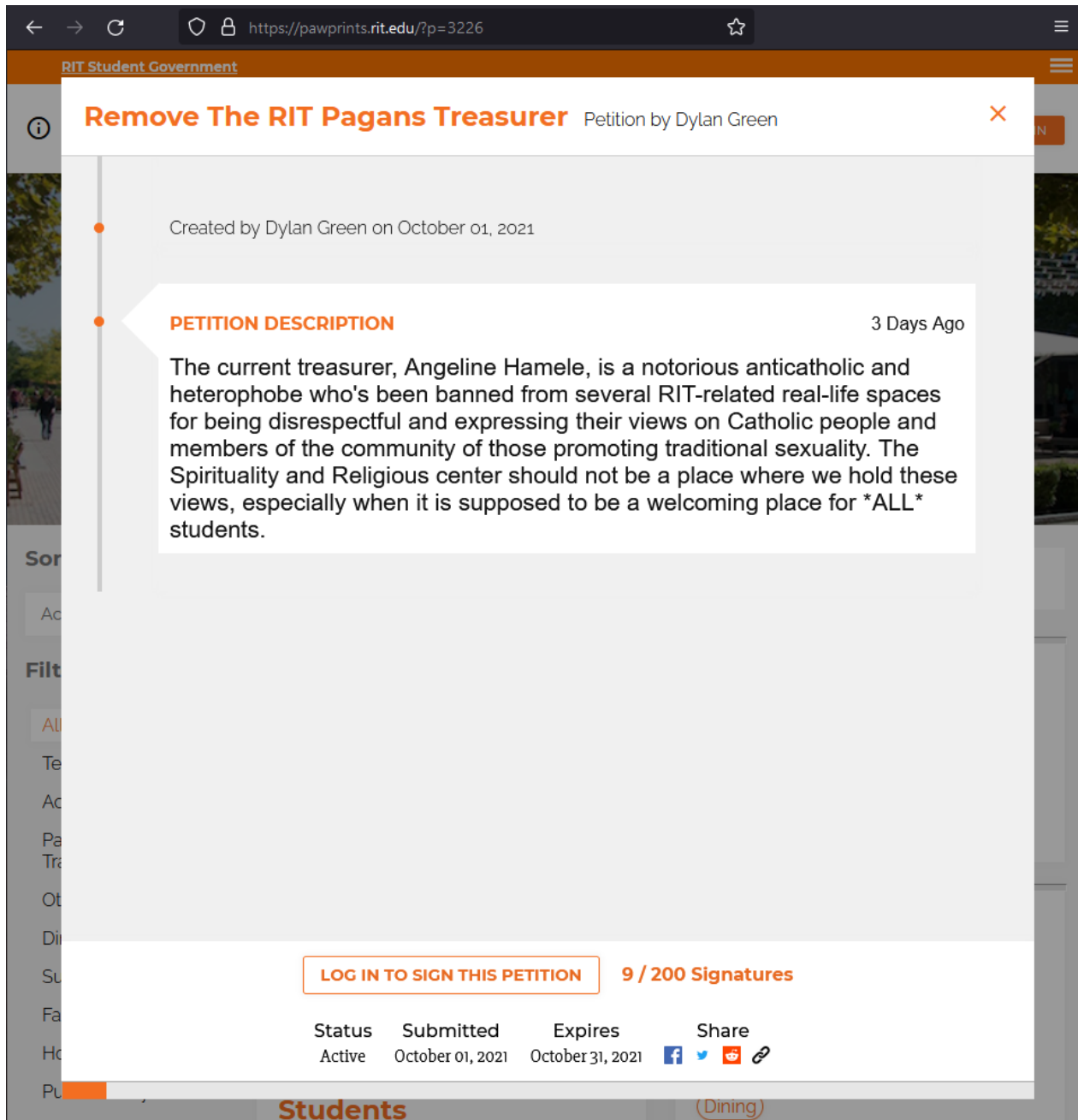


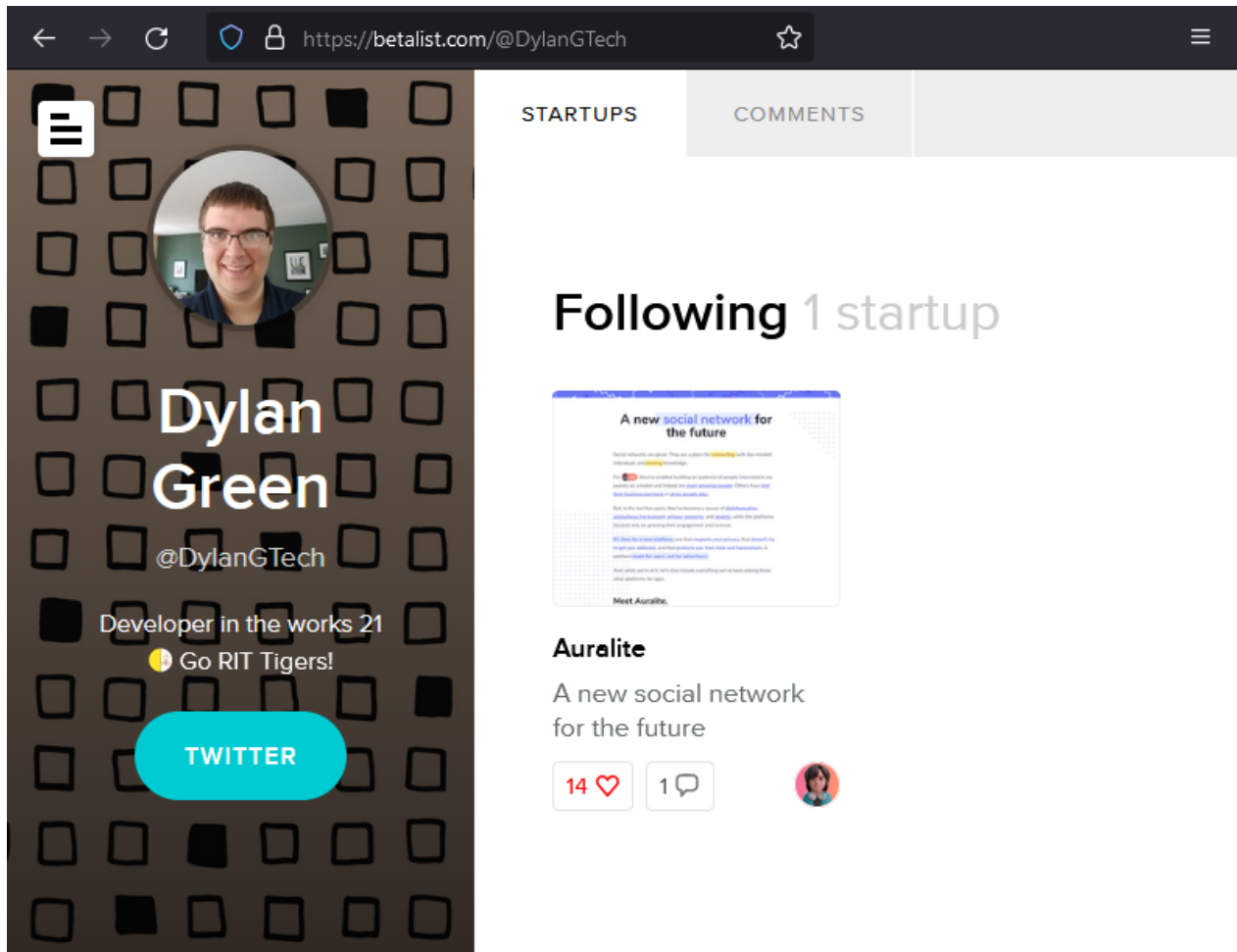
Figure 2: The second pawprints

A google search for “Dylan Green RIT” reveals his betalist account:

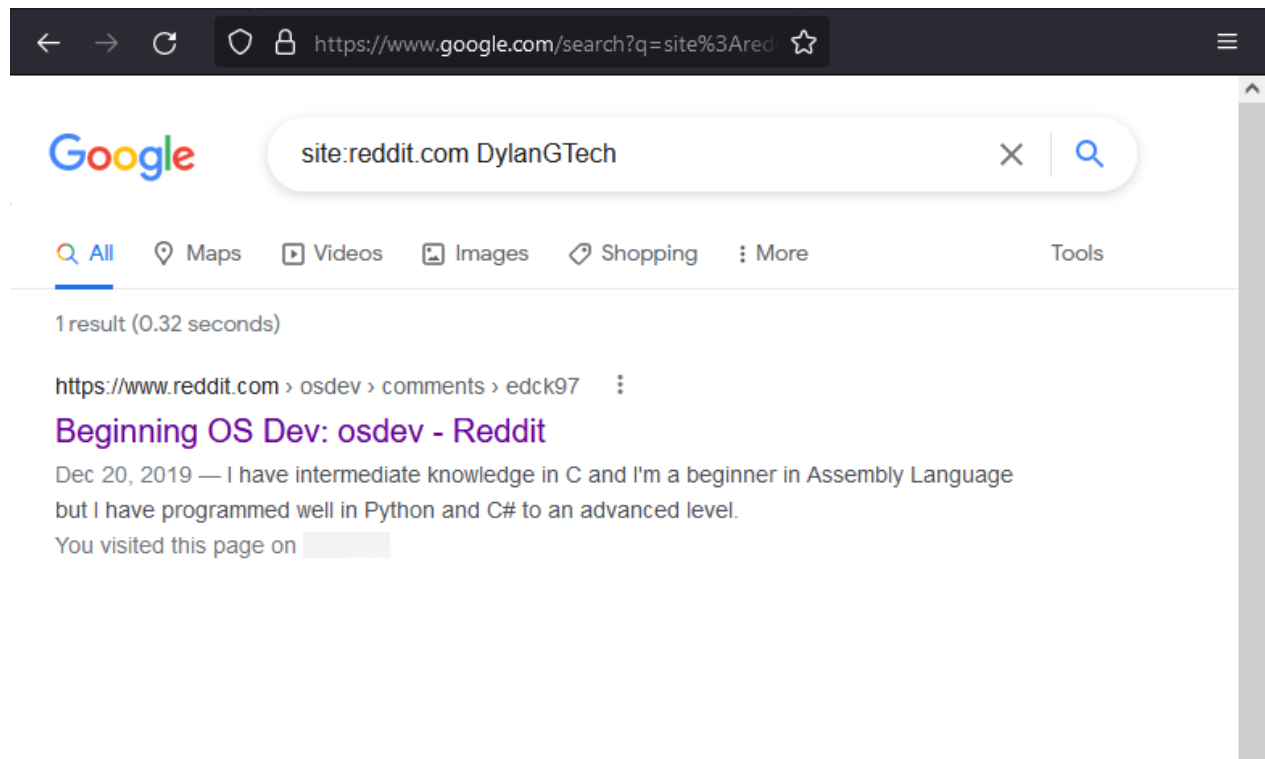

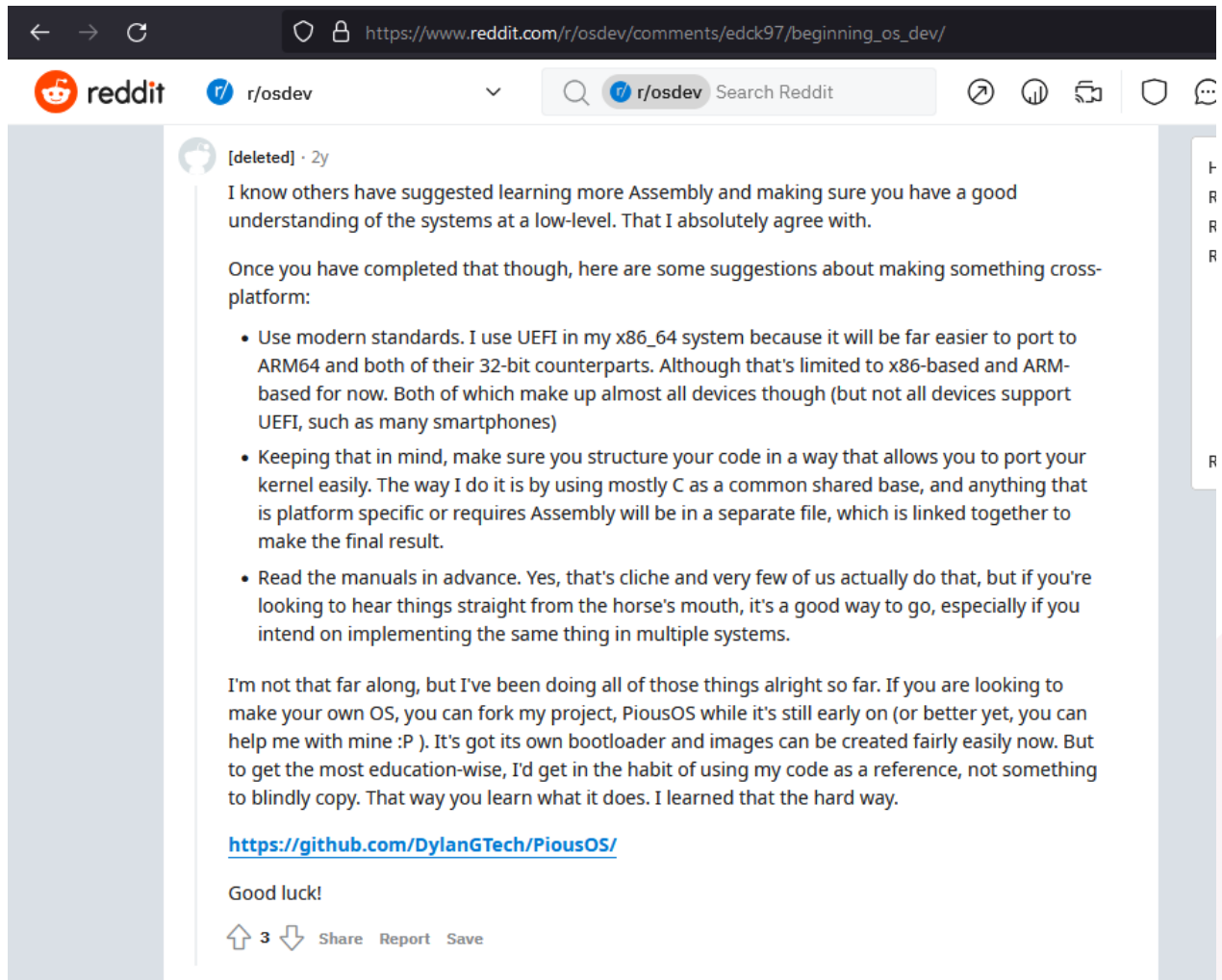

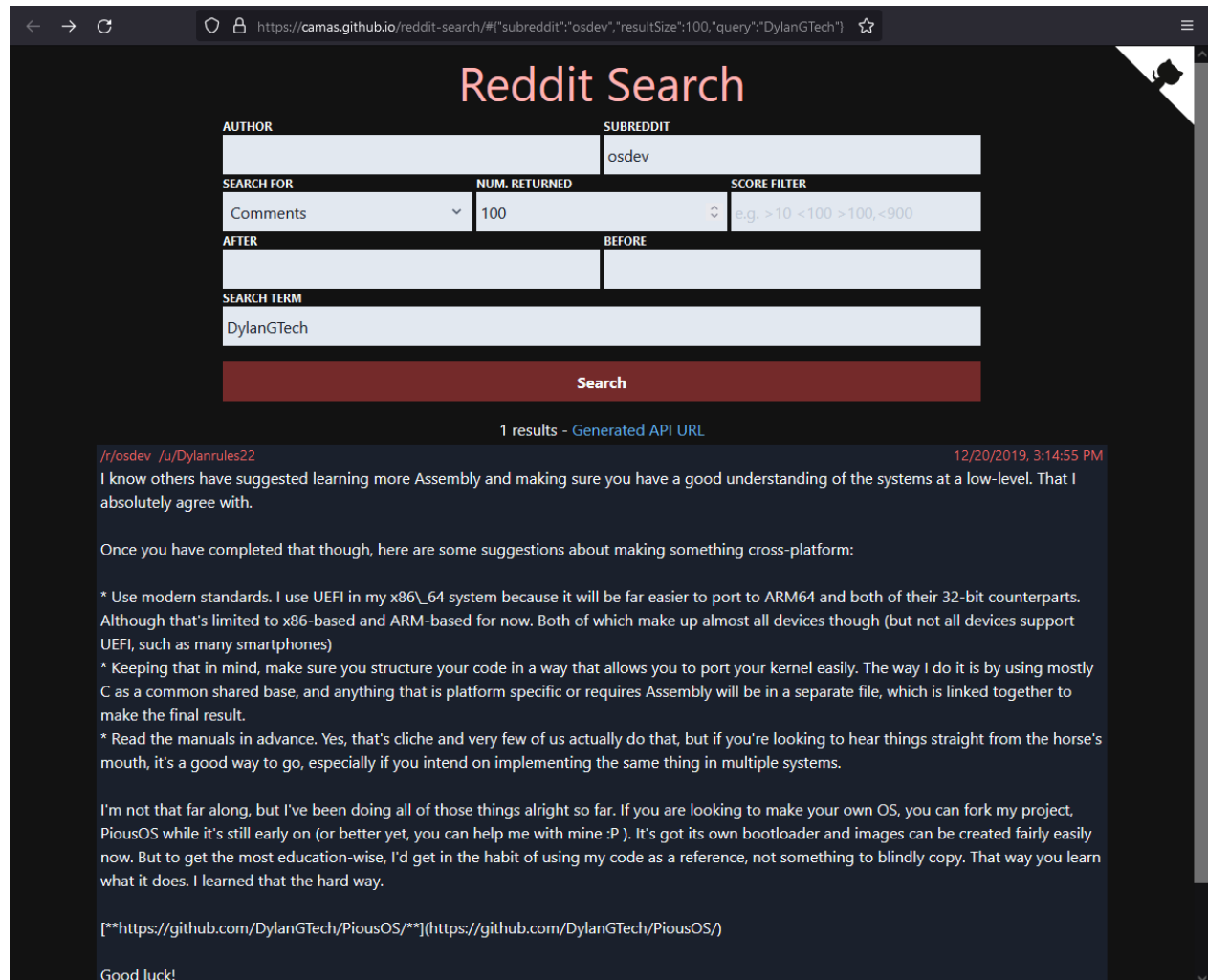
This comment appears to be from Dylan. It implies ownership of a project on github, owned by the DylanGTech username.

The account that posted this comment has been deleted. We cannot simply click on the username to see similar comments - we need the help of a reddit archival service.

We now have Dylan's reddit username, before he deleted the account: "Dylanrules22". We can then use the same archive service to search all of his reddit activity.

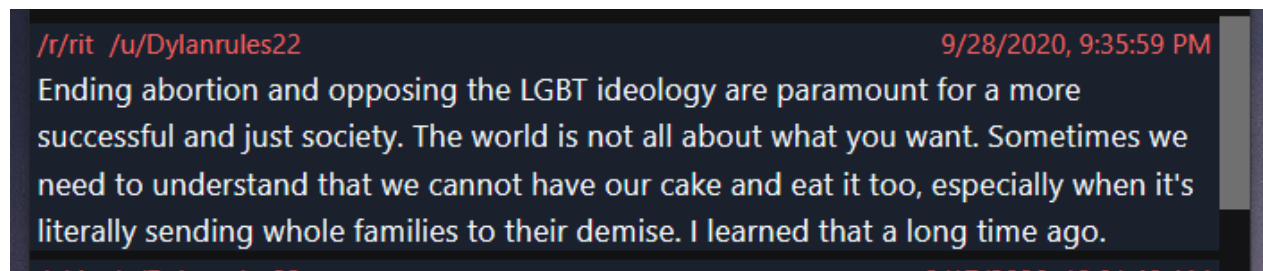

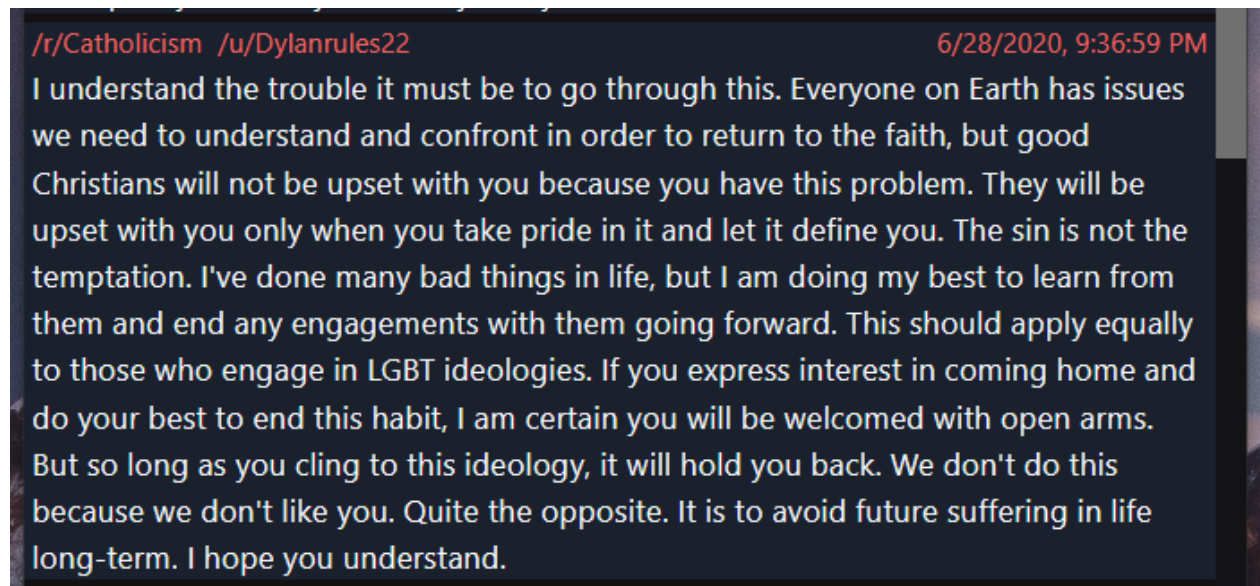

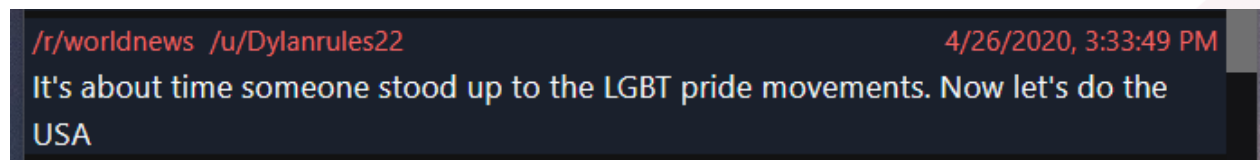


**Figure 6:** Society

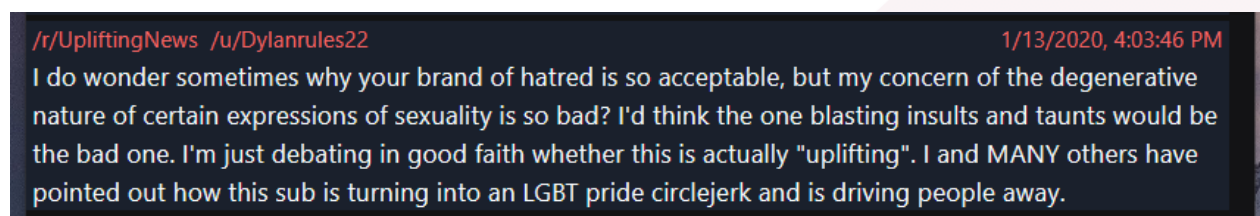




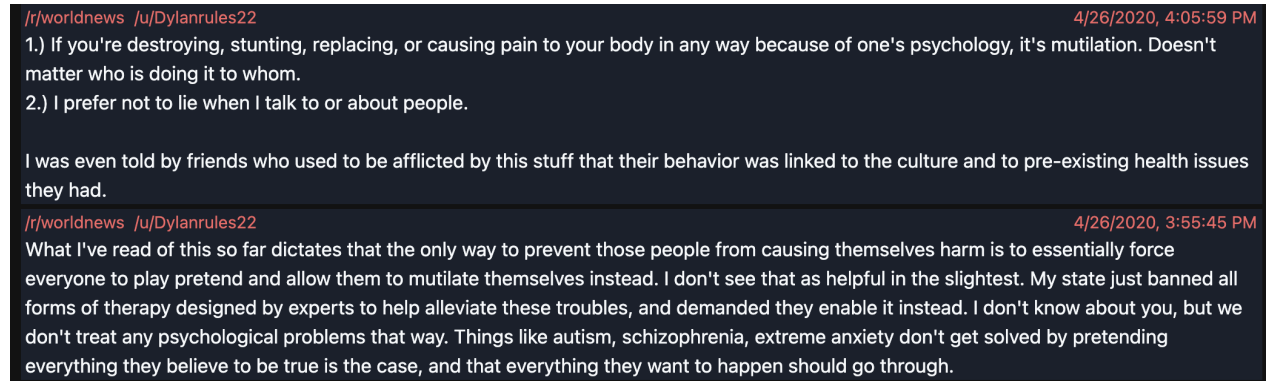
**Figure 7:** Just stop being lgbt



**Figure 8:** Time to stand up

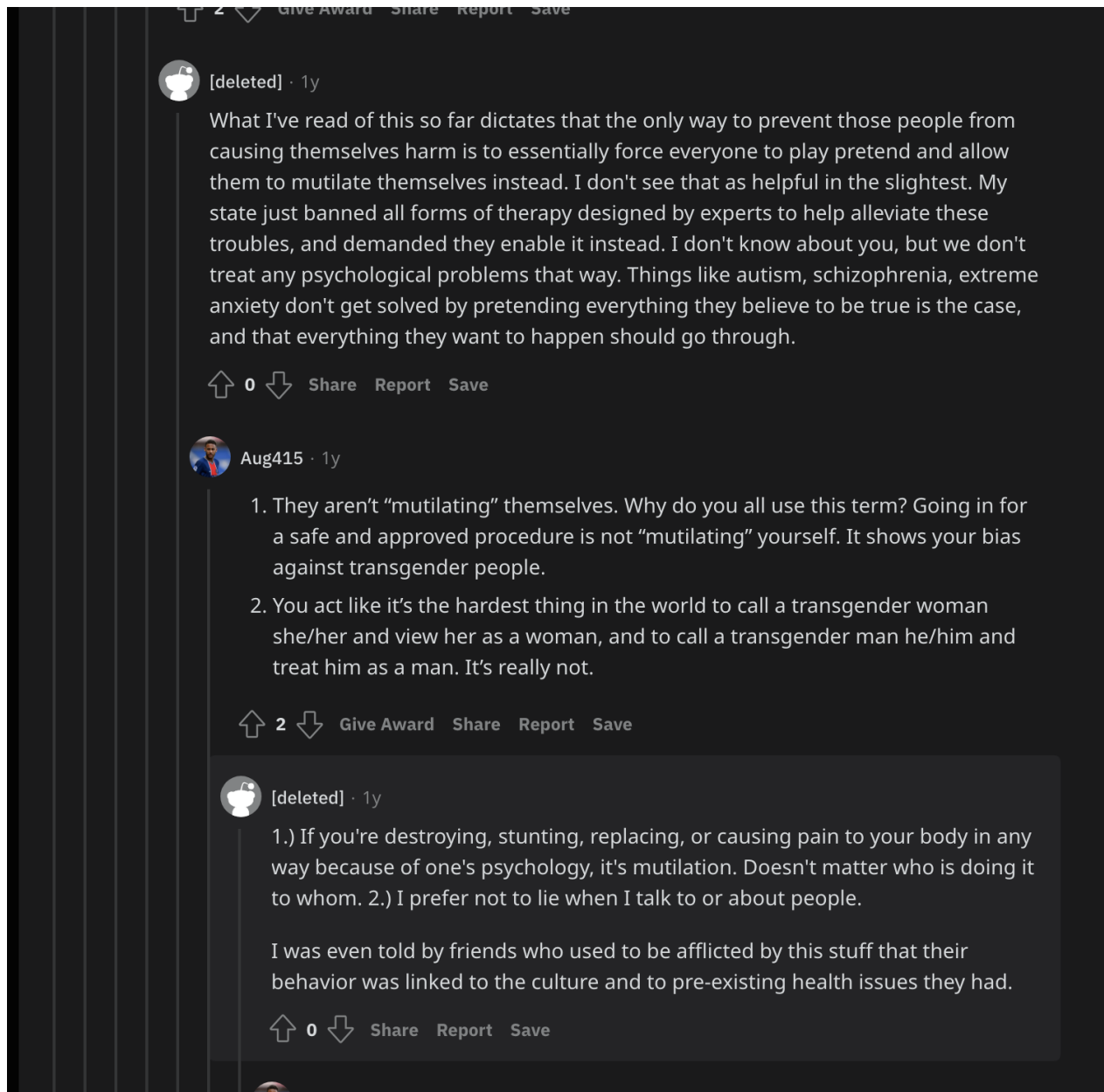


**Figure 9:** Degenerative expressions of sexuality

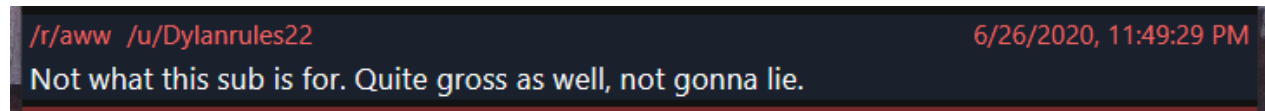
**Figure 14:** Abortion vs The Holocaust: part 2

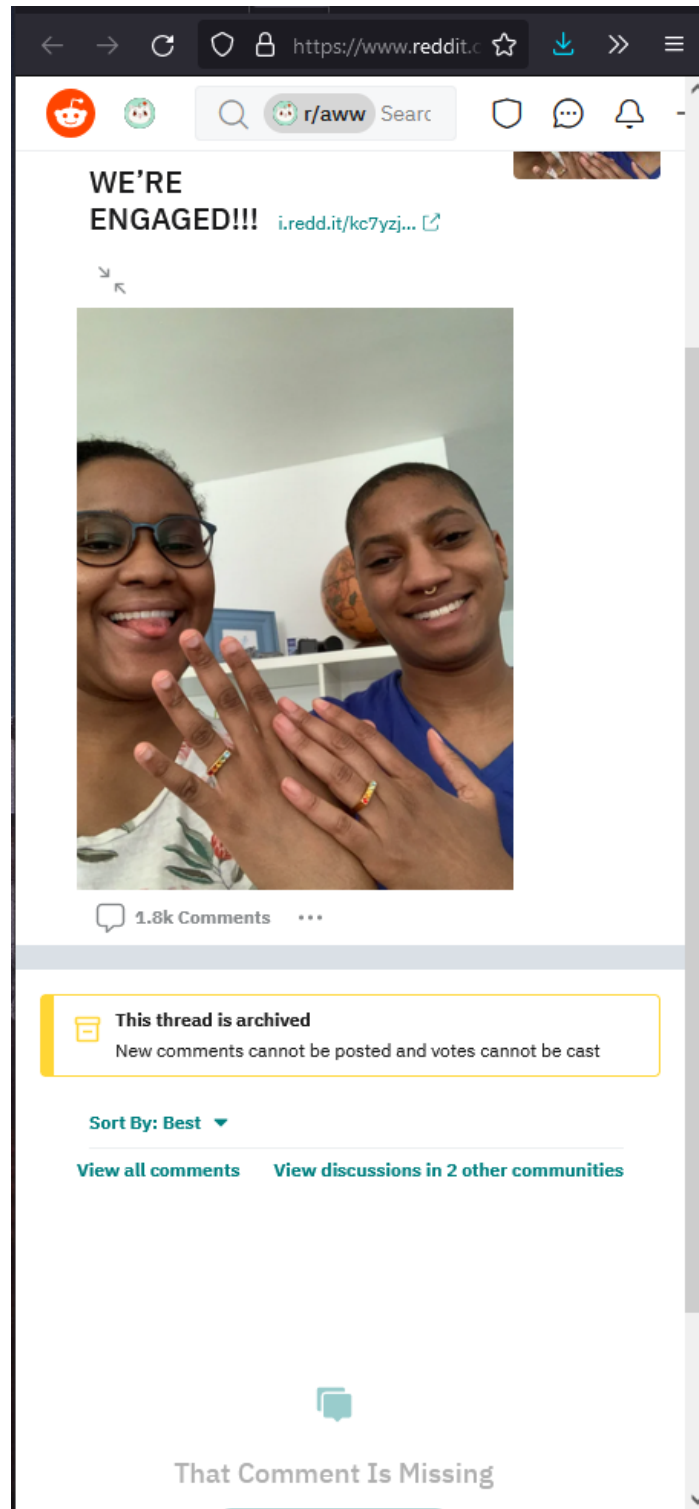

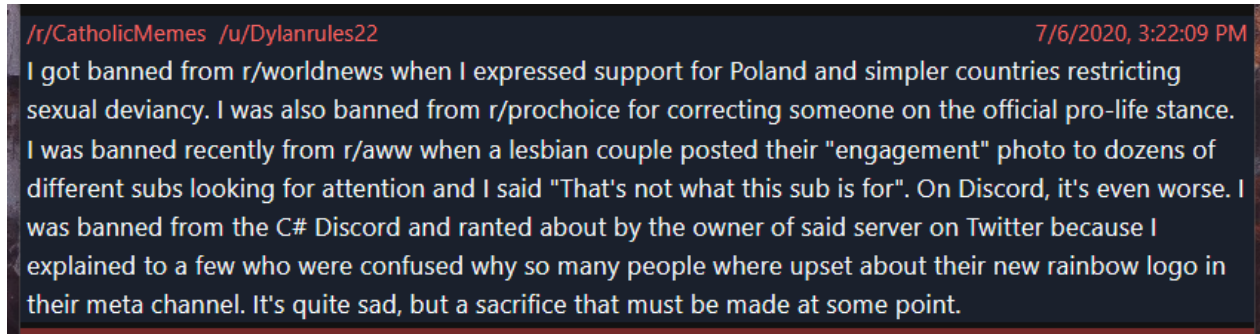


**Figure 16:** On a lesbian couple's engagement



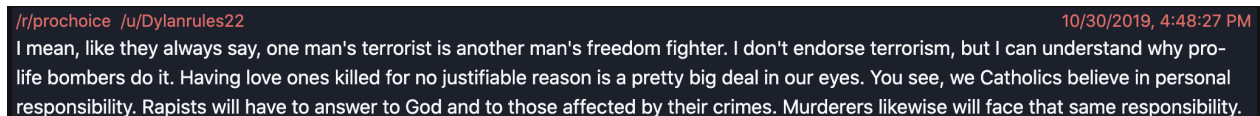
**Figure 17:** The comment was removed

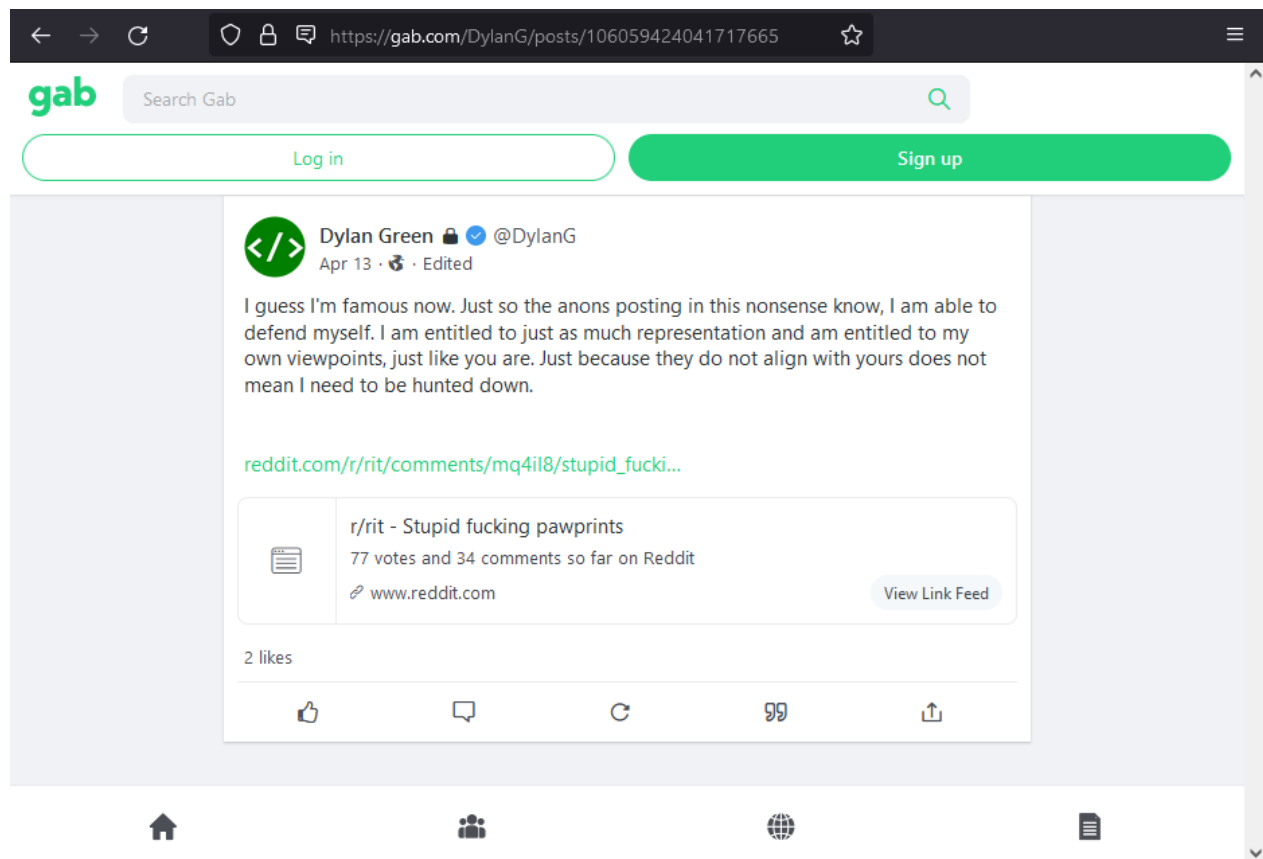
**Figure 19:** Sympathizing with terrorists

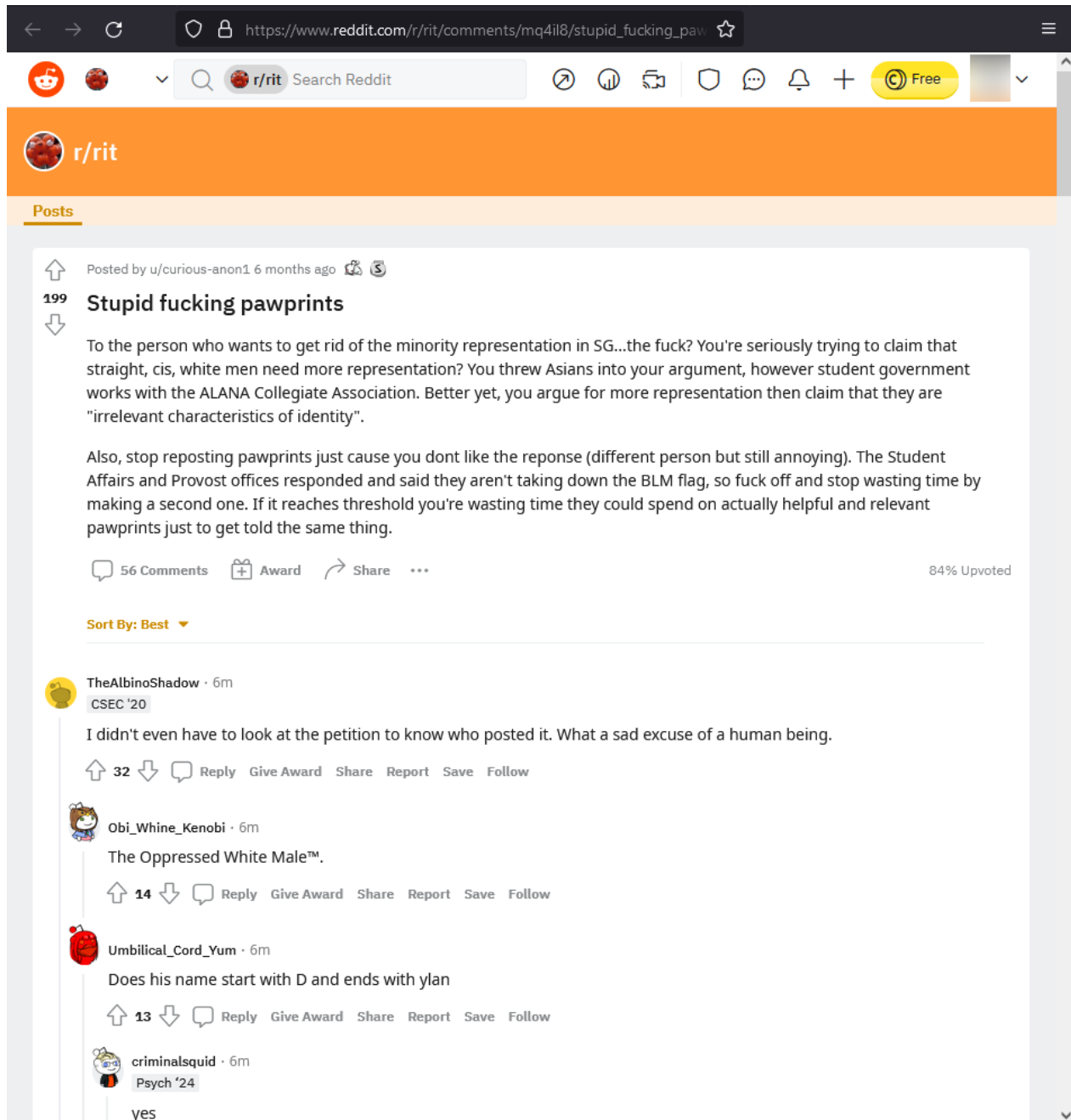


Figure 21: Persistence

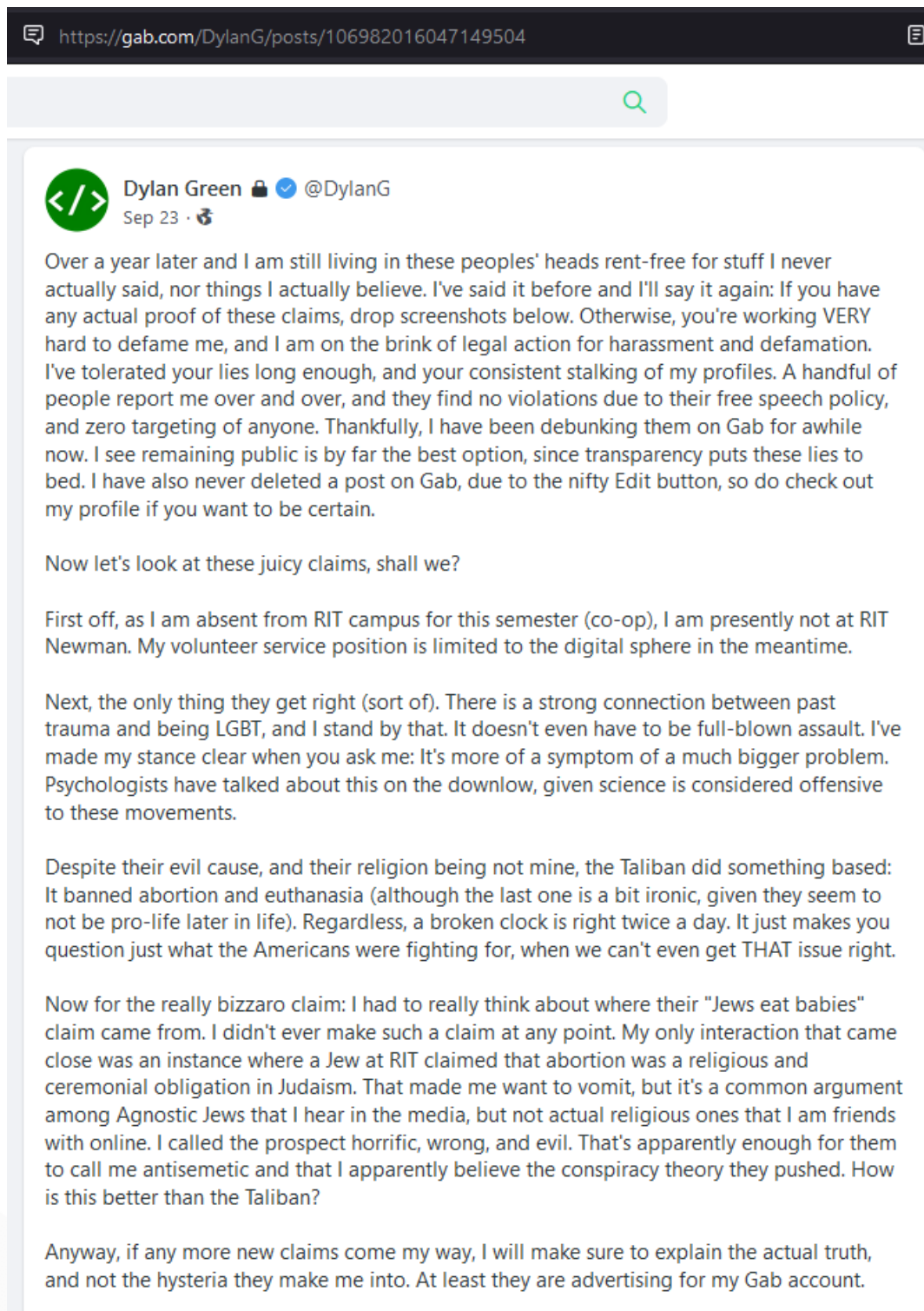
The screenshots posted here are mostly short - we have avoided including his longer posts - but we would

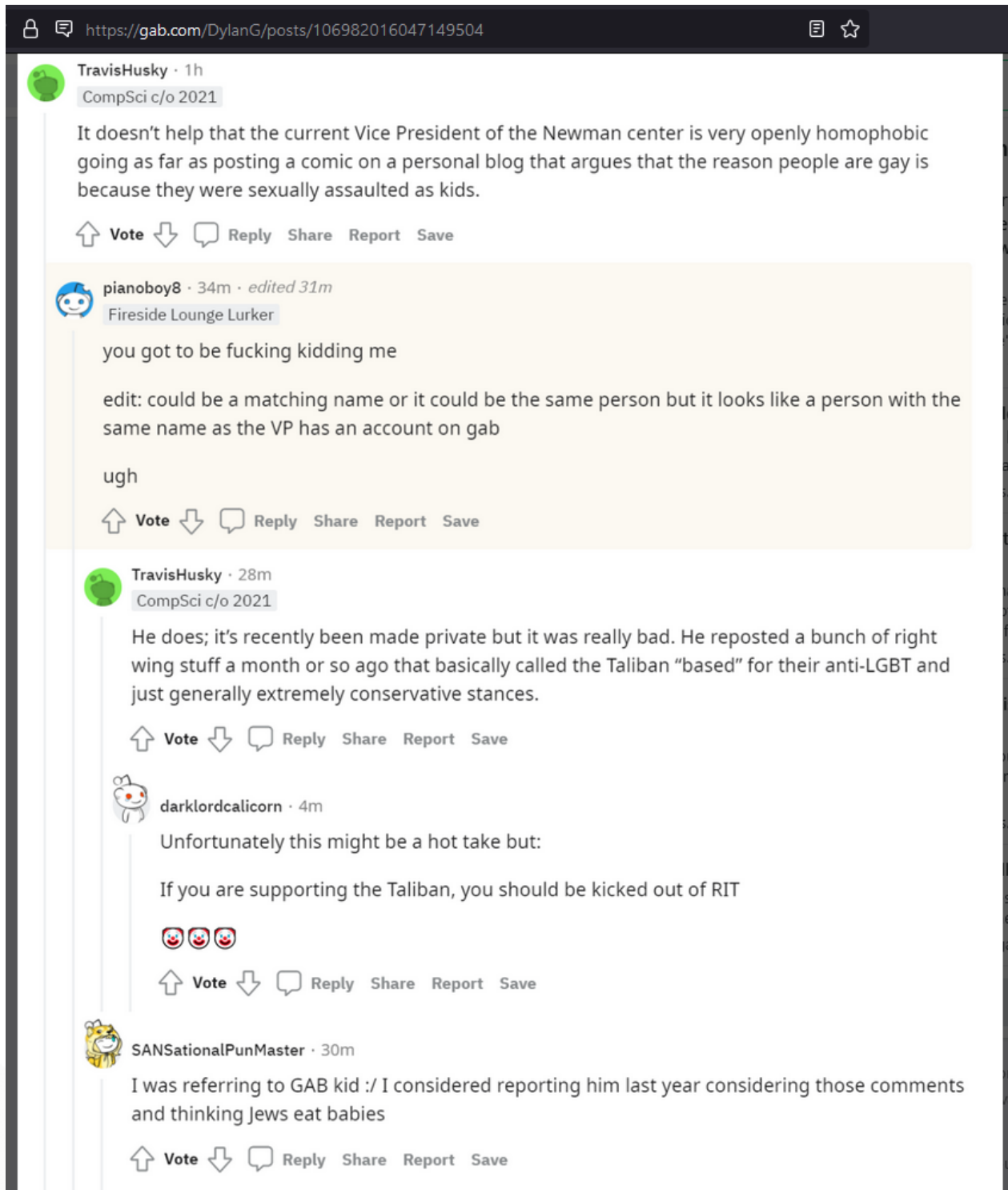


Figure 23: The Inspiration
